

Instructions: Cummins et al. article APA Formatting Activity

- Open the following from the “Labs” page on the website:
 - Cummins et al. 1977 (pdf)
 - Cummins et al. 1977 (docx)
- Reformat the Cummins et al. Word Document into APA Format (TIP: use the pdf to refer back to while editing the Word doc into APA format)
 - **The assignment MUST be turned in as a MS Word Document!**
 - Separate the article into the proper APA sections (i.e., Title page, Abstract, Introduction, Method, Results, Discussion, References)
 - Keep in mind proper APA format for each section.
 - Correct the references for the Reference section using full APA citations
 - Google and visit the OCC Library to search for the articles in the reference section to find the full citations
 - Authors, dates, article titles, full names of the journals, issue/volume, page numbers, doi numbers
 - Don’t forget to use correct APA format for In-text citations as well!
 - replace the numbers used in the text and replace them with the correct corresponding references using APA format (i.e., author’s names and article years)
