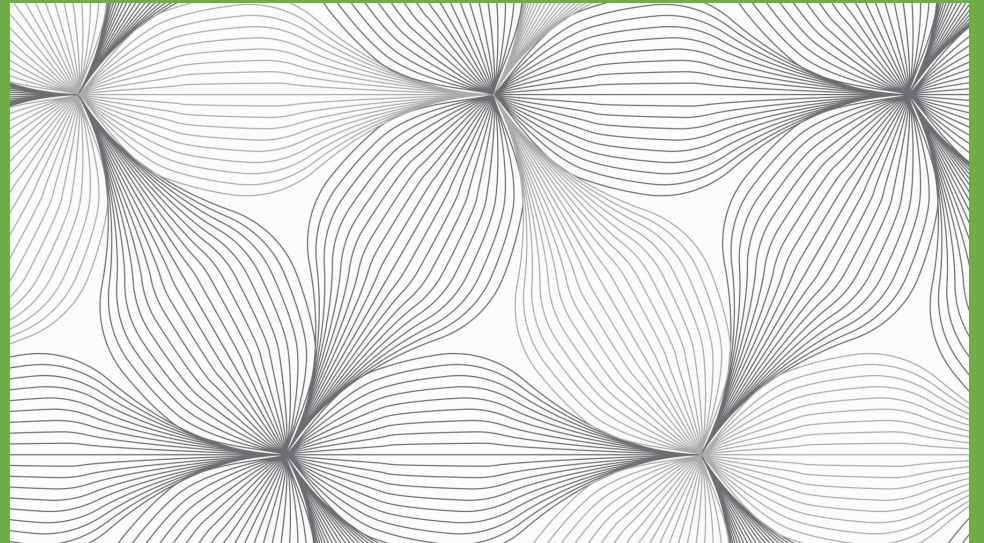


Instructions: Group Research Projects



Group Research Projects

- Group Research Projects are conducted **Collaboratively and Individually**
 - **Collaborative Work:** Developing a research question/hypothesis to study, collecting supportive literature, designing the research study, finding/creating research instruments/surveys/materials, collecting data, running data analysis, presenting your research to the class
 - **Individual Work:** **Each student is responsible for writing his/her own APA Format paper for this research**
- Students will form groups of 2 or 3 to conduct a collaborative form of research study.
- Research projects will be based on an agreed upon topic of interest
 - They can be replications of current research or based on an original idea

Groups

- Research projects **MUST** be Experimental
 - We will discuss this in class and for your Research Project Approval Forms
- Projects will be scored on creativity, strength of the design, effort, amount of data collected (approx. 30 subjects).
- Individuals who fail to fully contribute to their group project, as assessed by the instructor and peer ratings on the last day of class, will be penalized.
